

BYU to Host Western Conference Tournament

After finishing second in the Western Conference, BYU will host the Western Conference Tournament, essentially the Sweet Sixteen, Friday and Saturday at South Stadium.

“This is a great opportunity and a true honor for us to have this opportunity,” head coach Chris Watkins said. “It’s a testament to our excellent facilities and our team. I’m proud of how far we’ve come this season.”

Friday will feature a double header with games at 5:30 and 8 p.m., respectively. In the first game Abbotsford (9-4-3), the first-place finisher in the Northwest Division, will face Orange County (10-4-2), which finished second in the Southwest Division.

BYU (9-6-1) will then take on Southern California (13-3-0), the top-ranked team in the Southwest Division, in the second game.
