

Cougars Advance to Western Conference Championship

The BYU Men's Soccer Team, who hold the PDL's Northwest Division Title, beat the San Fernando Valley Quakes 2-0 in the first playoff game of the 2007 season.

The physical game remained scoreless until the 64th minute when Steven Fellows finished a ball delivered by Brock Trejo to give the Cougars a 1-0 lead. Only eight minutes later, Fellows scored his second goal of the night off of an assist from BYU's Doug Clark. The Cougar's defense held strong shutting out the Quakes.

"This was a huge result for us," said BYU head coach Chris Watkins. "This win puts us in a good position to advance to the semi-finals."

With the win, the Cougars advance to the western conference finals for the second straight year. They will play the Fresno Fuego, who defeated the Tacoma Tide in the other playoff matchup. The game will take place on Saturday July 28, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. (MST) at Chukchansi Park in Fresno.
